Nothing But The Blood

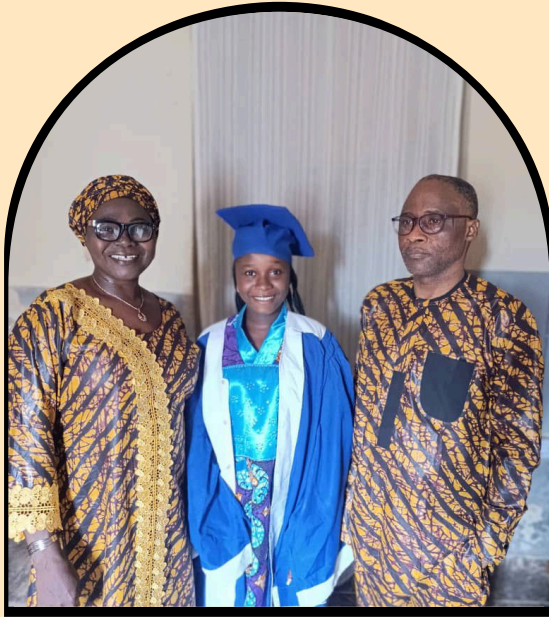
What can wash away my sin?
